- **Environment Awareness**

- **Important SMC Decisions**

- The school Principal, while starting the meeting, presented before all members a proposal to increase the school fee in order to support development works of the school, repair of basic facilities, supply of sports materials, and improvement in co-curricular activities. The members discussed the financial condition of the school and emphasized the need to consider future requirements while discussing the fee increase.
- In the current session, a detailed report of the school's income and expenditure was presented. The committee unanimously approved a fee increase of **6% to 8%** and decided that the proposed increase will be implemented from the next academic session **2026–27**.
- During the discussion, **Dr. Neelendra Nigam** also expressed that the increased fee should be properly utilized to improve the quality of teachers and to strengthen the academic system of the school.
- The Principal informed that in the academic session **2025–26**, due to the increase in the number of students and sections, the need for appointing new teachers was discussed in detail. During the meeting, information about the vacant posts in the school was presented, and emphasis was laid on the requirement of qualified and trained teachers to maintain the quality of education.
- The committee members agreed to adopt an appropriate selection process for appointing suitable candidates for various subjects and to ensure compliance with the relevant standards and regulations.
